McKay Scholarship Program

The John M. McKay Scholarships for Students with Disabilities Program allows parents of students with disabilities to choose the best academic environment for their children. This program provides eligible students the opportunity to attend a participating private school or transfer to another public school. Eligible students include students who have been issued an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or a 504 Accommodation Plan that is effective for more than 6 months. Students must also have been enrolled and reported for funding by a Florida school district the year prior to applying for a scholarship.

Voicing Their Choice


Over the past decade, thousands of parents have chosen the McKay Scholarship Program. During the 2016-17 school year, \$220.2 million was paid to scholarship program participants. The state calculated maximum scholarship amount for IEP students enrolled ranged from \$4,970 to \$24,096, averaging \$8,021. The average amount for students with a 504 Plan was \$4,562.




McKay Scholarship Program Continues to Grow

Since 2000-01, student participation in the McKay Scholarship Program has continued to grow. In 2016-17, 31,499 students from 1,454 private schools participated in the program. Private schools participating in McKay must document compliance with eligibility requirements specified in law.






McKay Students by Grade Level

Public school student counted in the prior school year's October and February FTE surveys, with an IEP or a 504 Plan that is effective for more than 6 months. Students who received Specialized Instructional Services (SIS) under the Voluntary Prekindergarten Program during the previous year.

McKay Scholarship Program Public School Option

The McKay public school program provides educational options for parents of students with disabilities in grades K-12 living in Florida. Eligible students may attend a different public school in their own district, or a public school in a neighboring district if space is available.
